

VALUE-ADDED ONLINE COURSES BY LEARNING PATH

A suite of updated value-added online courses is available at no cost to all Ohio K–12 public schools as part of Race to the Top.

Organized into four role-based learning paths, the following interactive online courses will help educators to further understand, interpret and use EVAAS[®] value-added analysis to inform practices and accelerate student progress. The courses are designed for educators to work independently or with a professional learning team.
